## ORDER PERMITTING LIMITED DISCOVERY

Michael E. Hegarty, United States Magistrate Judge.

On March 15, 2020, I entered a temporary stay in this case until April 30, 2020. ECF 50. In anticipation of the parties commencing limited discovery after that day, I requested a status report on April 27, 2020, which the parties have provided. ECF 55. It is apparent that the restrictions engendered by the COVID-19 pandemic will be lifted in stages commencing soon. Plaintiff has proposed engaging in limited discovery, including (1) Defendants responding to discovery requests served February 14, 2020; (2) Defendants commencing production of documents for which they are not stating an objection; (3) Defendants having leave to serve written discovery requests on Plaintiff; (4) Plaintiff commencing production of documents for which it is not stating an objection; and (5) the parties constructing a protective order. Defendants oppose lifting the stay based on the reasons stated by the Court on March 15, 2020, including the pandemic and the continued pendency of the motion to dismiss.

I find Plaintiff's suggestion to be modest and supported by the needs of the litigation.

Therefore, the steps that Plaintiff requests are adopted, and the parties may proceed. The parties

shall file another status report on or before **June 30, 2020** to advise the Court of their respective positions concerning the progression of this case.
