Dear Senator Loeffler:

As you are aware, the Select Committee on Ethics (the Committee) conducted a preliminary inquiry regarding allegations of potential insider trading in connection with the coronavirus pandemic. Specifically, the Committee reviewed transactions made by you and your spouse after January 6, 2020, which were the subject of complaints filed by Common Cause and Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington on March 20, 2020.

Based on all the information before it, the Committee did not find evidence that your actions violated federal law, Senate Rules, or standards of conduct. Accordingly, consistent with its precedent, the Committee has dismissed this matter.

As always, the Committee retains the authority to revisit this matter should additional facts become known to the Committee. Enclosed are copies of the complaints and the letters of dismissal to Common Cause and Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington.
