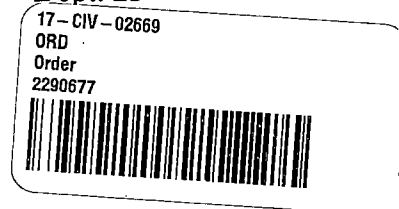

JUDGMENT AND MOTIONS TO
SEAL IN VIEW OF COVID 19
PANDEMIC**

The Federal Government, State Government and the County of San Mateo have declared states of emergency for the Coronavirus pandemic. The Public Health Officer for San Mateo County initially required that we institute all forms of social distancing to stem the spread of Coronavirus. Since this requirement was issued, the Public Health Officers in the six contiguous Bay Area counties have now issued a Shelter-In-Place order to go into effect at midnight on March 17, 2020. Accordingly, the Court has determined that all jury trials and law and motion matters may put the health of jurors, attorneys and court staff at risk. The more people who come to court the more increased the risk will be. Further, the Court anticipates staffing shortages, including bench officers and courtroom personnel.
