**ORDER**

Pending before the court is defendants' motion to continue the trial in this matter. (ECF No. 1181). That motion is **GRANTED** insofar as it requests a continuance of the trial and pretrial conference. Trial of this matter is **CONTINUED** until further order of the court. Plaintiffs are hereby invited to submit a proposal regarding the extent to which their case-in-chief could be presented remotely without receiving live testimony by remote means.

The pretrial conference scheduled for December 8, 2020, is **CONTINUED** until January 6, 2021, and February 3, 2021, both at 11:00 a.m., and via videoconference. Counsel for plaintiffs and defendants are to provide by email to Allison Skinner at [allison\\_skinner@wvsd.uscourts.gov](mailto:allison_skinner@wvsd.uscourts.gov) no later than three business days prior to the videoconference, the following information: the name, telephone number, and email of each attorney participating in the conference. Once this information is received and processed, the court will contact the participants with connection details.


